Instructions for Hyposensitization Medications

As the allergy serum is custom made for your pet you will be asked to pre-pay with a Visa or Mastercard when ordering a refill.

Please continue giving 1.0cc of the allergy serum every 20-21 days. Finish what is left in the old vial before moving on to a new vial. If you have a partial dose left in the old vial you may draw it into the syringe and then go to the new vial and draw from it until you have a full 1.0cc dose.

Please call at least one week before your new vial is needed. Vials can be shipped out overnight for an additional \$25 charge. Because the serum may lose its potency if left out of the refrigerator for long periods of time it is shipped by express mail and delivered in 1-2 days. If this service is desired, please leave a Visa, Mastercard, or Discover credit card number when ordering your vial.

Your pet may experience occasional flare-ups of the allergies while on the allergy injection treatment, especially during hot and humid summer months, or the fall pollen season. Topical medications, steroids, antihistamines, or shampoos may be needed to help control your pet's allergies during these times.
